MEDICAL BILLING & CODING

This 80 hour Billing & Coding course covers the following areas: CPT (Introduction, Guidelines, Evaluation and Management), specialty fields (such as surgery, radiology and laboratory), ICD-10 (Introduction and Guidelines) and basic claims processes for medical insurance and third-party reimbursements. Students will learn how to find the service and codes using manuals, (CPT, ICD-10 and HCPCS).

Requirements

Must be 18 years old. A high school diploma or GED is required.
