Forklift Training Program

Train New Hires or Re-certify Employees

Forklift training is required for all individuals using a forklift. Forklift training is mandatory and requires both classroom and hands-on experience.

Although the operation of a forklift is similar to that of a car, there are important differences. Differences include the speed, visibility, load stability, lack of stability on inclines or declines, path smoothness (potholes etc), load height, load rigging, etc.

Training is provided by Iowa Central Community College to companies who move heavy objects (usually on pallets) that would otherwise be difficult to move. Using a forklift carries responsibilities.
