

The following states currently recognize the National Registry of EMTs (NREMT) Paramedic cognitive and psychomotor exams for initial certification/licensure. The Iowa Central Paramedic program curriculum meets the requirements for National Registry of EMTs cognitive and psychomotor testing.

Individual states may have additional requirements in order to seek certification/licensure in their respective state. We advise that you contact the individual state office that oversees EMS certification/licensure to inquire about all certification/licensure requirements in addition to NREMT requirements.
