## Associate of Arts Credit Hour Percentages



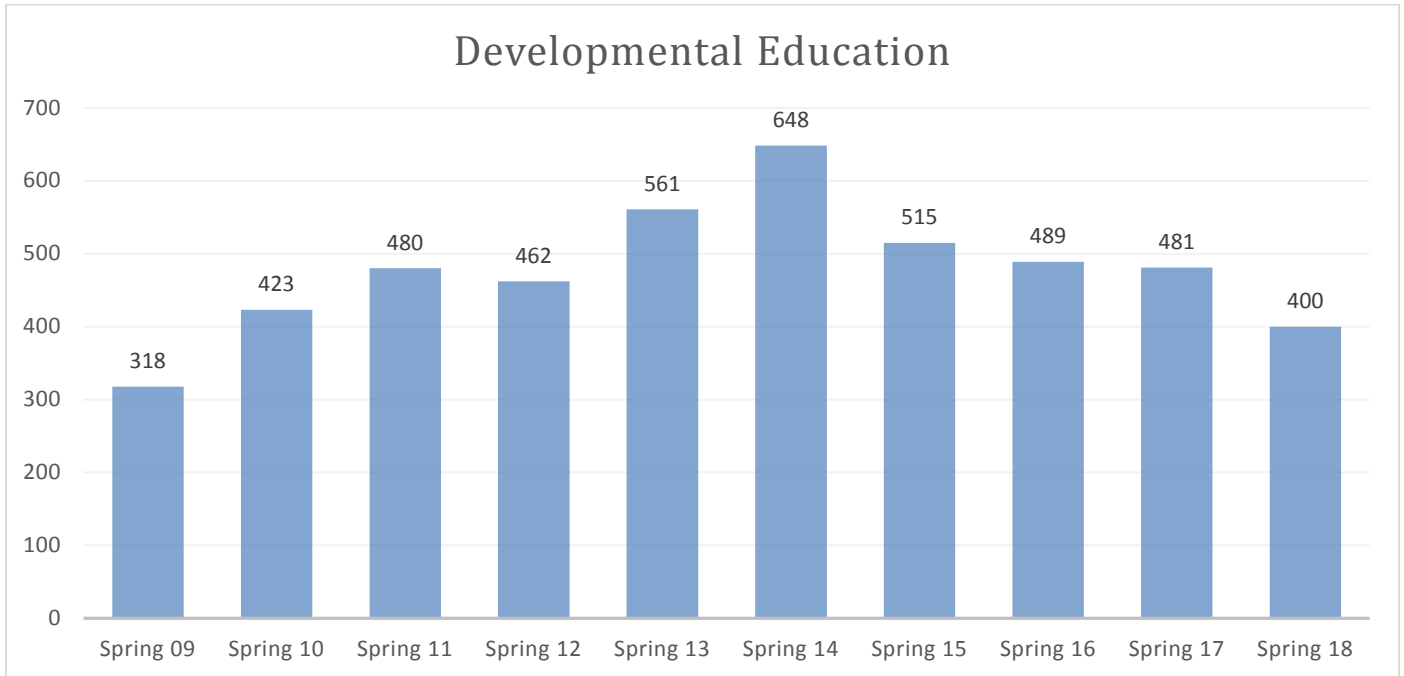
