These tools are required for the program. (*Good - used tools are acceptable*)

1. Federally approved safety glasses

4. Carpenters tool box—optional
5. Tool belt or Nail apron – leather or Cordura
6. Claw hammer – Straight claw 16 to 22 oz.
7. Cartridge respirator
8. One 25' to 35' steel tape (*Stanley 16" and 19.2" centers indicated*)
9. 100' steel tape
10. Speed Square
11. Framing Square (*with rafter table*)
12. Torpedo level
13. Nail puller (*cat's paw*)
14. 2-#2-2" Phillips bit
15. 2-#2-1" Phillips bit
16. Utility knife (*retractable blade*)
17. Chalkline
18. 2-2" t-25 torx bit
19. Two Nail sets 1/32" and 1/16"
20. Drywall saw
21. Coping saw
22. Screw driver (5 way)
23. Pencils
24. 1 Pair straight tin snips (WISS)
25. Rubber overshoes or slip on rubber boots for concrete work.
