Welding Technology Equipment List:

The following is the list of tools required for enrollment in the Welding Technology program. Since the objective of our program is to train students for employment as welders, these tools will allow the student to start his/her personal tool kit, adding to it as he/she wishes. We highly recommend that quality be purchased. Many students will have some of these tools already. If so, it would not be necessary to purchase new ones.

Approximate cost for tools is \$175.00-\$350.00 for the entire program

Equipment required for students entering Welding Program. **Note:** These will need to be purchased on your own.

1. Safety Glasses
2. Padlock / Pens / Pencils / Paper
3. Leather Boots – No Tennis Shoes
4. 4 ½ inch Grinder

The following equipment is included in the Beginning Welding course fees. Students that are NOT enrolled in the Beginning Welding course will also need to purchase the following equipment. **Note:** These can be purchased through Iowa Central Community College on the first day of classes as a tool kit or on your own.

1. Leather Gloves
2. Leather Welding Jacket or Green Welding Jacket
3. Pliers or Wire Cutters
4. Welding Helmet
5. Sheet Metal Thickness gauge
